## Year 9 Teaching and Learning Cycles

In order for us to measure progress that students at Scott College are making, we are required to assess them in the first two weeks of term to give us a 'baseline assessment'.

We will use the GL Assessment suite that measures attainment in Maths, English and Science. Students will sit straightforward tests using their Chromebook, that are marked automatically by GL and will quickly give us an indication of the levels that they are working at based on a national database. This will assist us in setting aspirational targets for future GCSE grades. We will share the reports from these assessments with parents and our local governors.

Each academic year we will have four teaching and learning cycles, each lasting nine weeks. Towards the end of the first three teaching cycles students will be assessed on their learning in the current teaching cycle. The final week of the learning cycle is to allow consolidation of any areas of learning that are shown to need improvement as a result of the assessment. An end of year 'final assessment' will take place at the end of the fourth teaching cycle in the summer term, to prepare students for future GCSEs and A levels.

The outcomes from each teaching cycle will be reported to parents, local governors and the Trustees of Scott College.
